### MORE POLICE = MORE ARRESTS

As most of us are aware by now 20 new police officers have arrived at the Tweed Byron Local Area Command, and I think it would be fair to say that these new officers are already helping to make a difference.

A 17 year old youth was recently arrested by police for breaking Court Imposed Bail. The youth is currently on bail for serious matters. He was taken to Acmena Juvenile Detention Centre at Grafton.

Armed robbery of the NAB Bank at South Tweed, plus a major theft from a South Tweed retailer took place in broad daylight just before Christmas.

A male was arrested when police attended a property at Urliup. Police located a number of cannabis plants, further investigation lead to a quantity of dried cannabis leaf being located.

Well we are tops again in the Tweed Byron LAC for the arrest of drink drivers. Total amount caught last year was 297 one of the highest in the state. Last year 24,500 were arrested in NSW. 10% were caught between 6AM and midday. It is obvious that people do not heed police warnings.

Malicious damage to property along the Tweed Coast is still a problem where senseless damage is carried out by people who do not care about other people's property. Should you have your property vandalized or you see people carrying out this crime call the police straight away. It is unfortunate that some people do not report crime, all this is doing is allowing the person carrying out this crime to get away without charge. Remember malicious damage costs the victim money, this could be your money.
