IDENTITY THEFT

THIS IS A SERIOUS PROBLEM.. THE FOLLOWING WILL HELP PROTECT YOU SHOULD YOU LOSE YOUR WALLET OR HAVE YOUR HOME BROKEN INTO.

- Lock all personal documents in a safe if possible
- Don't carry personal information unless necessary
- Destroy personal info before putting in rubbish bin
- Lock the letterbox!!
- Don't respond to mail or email offers of money, lottery wins etc
- Don't store personal details on mobile phones
- (Bluesnarling is the theft of info from a wireless device through Bluetooth, turning off the discoverable feature will limit this)
- Use passwords and access controls for computers
- Avoid giving personal details on a public computer
- Regularly update anti virus protection.
- Never click on a link or attachment if sender unknown
- Avoid giving personal info over the phone
- Check caller ID on phone if suspicious of caller.

EMERGENCY CONTACTS

SHOULD YOU NEED THIS, THE OPERATOR WILL ASK, WHICH SERVICE YOU NEED, FIRE... AMBULANCE... OR... POLICE...

- 1) **TELL THE OPERATOR THE ADDRESS**
- 2) **STREET NAME**
- 3) **SUBURB**
- 4) **NEAREST CROSS STREET...**

A handy hint is to have your doctor, hospital, and local police number next to the phone... or taped on the phone..

The LATEST LOCAL SCAM is the "Bituman Bandits", again offering cheap driveway work, a local country lady recently paid \$3000.00 to these people! Please tell all your out of town friends and family to be aware!

Once again there have been phone calls and emails from TELECOM OR TELSTRA asking to update your records etc. THIS IS A SCAM.. DO NOT GIVE YOUR DETAILS OVER THE PHONE OR COMPUTER !!

We now have available an ELECTRIC ENGRAVER

These are available for your use for on children's bikes, skateboards, scooters, etc also for household items. TV, microwave, computers, anything of value that can be easily carried. Takes the difficulty out of identifying stolen goods.

REMEMBER SAFETY FIRST

Don't let strangers into your house

If they ask to use the phone, get the number and phone for them

If you are home alone NEVER admit to an unknown phone caller or person at the door

Ask to see identity cards if gas electricity or phone companies etc want to enter

If someone tries to snatch your bag, give it to them! But try and tip the contents out, they will grab the money and leave other valuables behind, no amount of money; is worth serious injury

We have had a couple of incidents in this area of someone trying to break into cars and homes at night, if your car is on the street, please make sure it is locked at all times, as well lock your house doors !!
