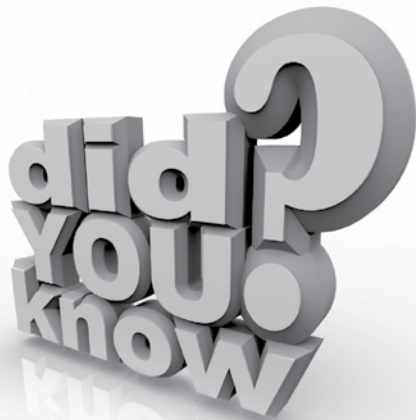

SCAMS: ALWAYS NEW ONES DOING THE ROUNDS. They can now be checked at Scamwatch: www.scamwatch.gov.au
If you're not sure - check it out!!

Latest SCAM: Someone from Australian Banking Association rings, checking your details, updates, etc. THERE'S NO SUCH ASSOCIATION - give nothing over the phone!

Emergency - what do I do?

D. R. A. B. C

DANGER: check yourself and the patient.

RESPONSIVE: Ask name, NO response open mouth, look for foreign matter... If responsive, check for injuries.

AIRWAY: Tilt head back, clear mouth, roll on side if a lot of foreign matter in mouth.

BREATHING: Look, listen and feel for breathing. If normal, leave patient on side. If NOT breathing, CALL 000 for Ambulance. Give 2 breaths check for signs of life.

CPR: NOT moving, NOT breathing, unconscious - Apply 30 breaths for 2 compressions of chest - continue until help arrives.
