BE VERY CAREFUL

I was advised by a lady who lives alone at Noble Park that on Easter Monday she happened to look out on her front balcony and saw a man standing there, when she enquired as to what he wanted he asked if he could look through her house. (House is up for sale). No agent was present or a representative from our management. Fortunately alarm bells rang and she refused to open her security door and let him in. How sensible was that. Never let anybody into your house who does not have security ID even then check the person out. If your house is for sale make sure that an agent or our Manager accompanies the person who needs to inspect your home. Should you really feel threatened get a good description of the person concerned and ring the police or Crime Stoppers. (All phone numbers are listed above).

HAVE YOU HEARD ABOUT THE FAKE \$50 BANK NOTES?

When you go shopping check your change especially \$50 notes, it appears that fake notes have been circulated around the Tweed shopping precincts and the fakes are hard to spot. Police have advised the best way to check is to crunch a fifty dollar bill in your hand, if it stays crunched up it is paper and will remain that way, legal bills are a plastic substance and will go back to shape. Police from both sides of the border are investigating, arrests have been made.

BREAK AND ENTERS

As you will note break enter and steal have dropped considerably during April along the Tweed Coast, police have advised that people carrying out these acts have been apprehended, It is not known at this time if these criminals were associated with the Noble Park issues. Never the less continue to take all precautions for home safety. It does appear that a person who was being targeted by police was also arrested for these crimes.

GRAFFITI

One of our NHW volunteers have taken a series of photographs of graffiti along the coast and supplied the photographs to Tweed Police, local police are looking into this problem and checking the tags with schools around the area for information, if anybody has any information regarding graffiti crime please contact police.
