BREAK AND ENTERS DROP ACROSS THE TWEED

Tweed police have report the number of break and enters in the command area of Tweed Byron have dropped by 37% over the last 24 months.

These figures may come as a surprise to residents who have read the data released recently by the Bureau of Crime Statistics and Research which indicated that the region had showed an increase in the number of break-ins by close to 36% over the last two years.

A police spokesman stated that figures released by the bureau included the Ballina and Lismore areas which showed significant increases in break and enters.

The local command area was only about 50% of the Tweed/Richmond region and therefore showed completely different results.

The Tweed/Byron area also experienced a decrease of about 35% in the number of break-ins of non dwellings and or business premises over the last two years and saw a 25% reduction in the number of thefts from cars.

An increase in detection of certain crimes indicated more vigilance and effective policing.

Policing in the Tweed was all about targeting theft and domestic violence where as policing in Byron Bay was focused more on alcohol related crime.
