

Remember DRABCD

CHECK .. 1) Danger 2) Response 3) Airway 4) Breathing 5) Circulation 6) Difibrillation or start CPR

CPR = CHILD AND ADULT 2 BREATHS TO 20 COMPRESSIONS..BABY 2 BREATHS TO 30 COMPRESSIONS

Continue until help arrives
