I have just found this - UPDATE FROM TWEED/BYRON POLICE:

INCREASE OF STEALING FROM MOTOR VEHICLE OFFENCES IN KINGSCLIFF AREA.

Please be aware that in recent days motor vehicles have either been left unlocked or keys located hidden on the outside of vehicles by offenders allowing easy access to motor vehicles in Marine Parade with valuable property being stolen.

Please DO NOT;

leave your car unlocked at any time

leave valuables in your car at any time

hide your keys on the outside of your motor vehicle (on top of tyres, in mufflers, radiator grills etc) whilst parked and unattended as there is always someone watching.....

PLEASE TAKE YOUR KEY/S WITH YOU OR BUY A SAFETY LOCK TO STORE YOUR KEY AND SECURE TO THE OUTSIDE OF YOUR CAR.

These situations create opportunistic theft!
