Dear Salt neighbours

I have sent, below, a warning from our local police and also a Facebook message from a local, warning about recent theft in our area.

Please take note and keep your homes and belongings safe.

A timely notice from Tweed/Byron LAC:

‘Public please secure your homes and vehicles.

We have an opportunistic few taking advantage of residents in the Kingscliff, and Casuarina areas.

We have had a number of reported thefts from motor vehicles and homes in February, which have been left open or with windows and door unsecured by their owners.

We would like to take this opportunity to remind the public to make sure your homes are locked and secured, and vehicles are always locked with windows up and no valuables left visible inside.

Thieves will take the smallest opportunity to relieve you of your belongings so don't give them the opportunity.

**LOCK IT UP,  
KEEP IT OUT OF SIGHT,  
SECURE YOUR CAR.**

‘Everyone please be mindful of locking doors and windows when you lock up and go to work etc.

This was last month, but she has only just notified me of this. Jewellery and laptops were stolen along with electrical tools from garage.

Please just take the time to check windows are locked!

A car was stolen last night, along with toolboxes!

My neighbour has had CCTV cameras fitted since.

Those of us lucky enough to have dogs, remember to not ignore a dog constantly barking. Most dogs don’t just bark at nothing. Even small house dogs are excellent watch dogs and the best alarm system.
